### **THE TRUTH IN FAMILY MYTHS AND LEGENDS – Speaker, Christine Green**

Stories are what make our family history come to life, put “flesh on the bones” of our ancestors. Stories are the best way to interest our families in genealogy. Although there is at least an element of truth in most family stories, it’s not always easy to separate the facts from fiction.

This talk explores several stories from the ordinary to the improbable in an attempt to separate the truth from the “Myths and Legends”.

**U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS)...**Genealogists can now turn to the USCIS for help in researching their family’s immigration history through the agency’s new Genealogy Program.

USCIS maintains historical records documenting the arrival and naturalization of millions of immigrants who arrived in the U.S. since the late 1800s or/and naturalized between 1906 and 1956. In many cases USCIS is the only government agency that has certain historical records that provide the missing link which genealogists or family historians need.

The new genealogy program will create a dedicated queue for genealogists, historians and others seeking genealogical and historical records and reference services that generally require no FOISA expertise. As a result, USCIS will provide more timely responses to requests for records of deceased individuals.

Submit genealogy records request by using the new forms, G-1041 – Genealogy Index Search Request, and G-1041A – Genealogy Records Request. Forms are available on the new USCIS Genealogy Program page at: <http://www.uscis.gov/genealogy>. The fees include:

Genealogy Index Search or Copy of a File on Microfilm - \$20 each

Copy of a Textual File Copy - \$35

### **BASIC FACTS FOR STARTING MY GERMAN FAMILY HISTORY RESEARCH**

In order to research your German ancestor, it is imperative that you know or discover the town or village in Germany from which he/she emigrated or the town or village where he/she was born or grew up.

Once you are able to discover the town or village where your German ancestor lived before immigrating to the U.S., consult Meyers ORTS, a Gazetteer of the German Empire, originally published in 1912. This gazetteer contains 210,000 place names of towns and villages in all areas that were part of the pre WW1 German Empire.

Ancestry has Meyers ORTs on line for free. *How to Use Meyers ORTS*, as well as *Handwriting Guide: German Gothic*, may be downloaded as a PDF file from FH L Research Guides. Hope you will have good luck and success in your German Research. (Edited from Shirley's talk at our June meeting)

### SOME TIPS AND INFORMATION TO BROADEN YOUR COMPUTER KNOWLEDGE

**Beware of SCAMS...** You get a popup window when you startup your computer or when you open your email account stating “there is a problem with your email account” or “there is a virus attempting to get into your files” (something of that ilk). For goodness sake **DO NOT CLICK ON IT!!** We all know better, but when in a hurry or when our mind is full of other problems, etc. it is easy to forget. A friend clicked on the “email problem” popup and had her mailing list stolen and the password to her account changed. Members of her email address list were sent letters explaining that she “was stranded in England, had lost her wallet, please respond so she could forward information which you could use to send \$3,250 via Western Union!” I got one of these letters. This friend is a highly educated woman and author of a few books. The English and grammar in the email was certainly NOT written by my friend! Beware....

**A Google Trick...** Go to [www.Google.com](http://www.Google.com) and enter the following: surname family history, using a surname or family from your ancestry. Example: “Storm family history”. When you see the display of “hits”, scroll down until you find one that reads (for example) “Timeline for Storm family History,” click on it and start looking through the list. At the bottom of the page you may want to click on “More timeline results.” You can also select specific time periods to look at for these surname hits.

To see some of the other tricks you can tie into, look at the video, “Using Google News Timeline for Genealogy,” which shows the many manipulations you can perform with Google’s timeline.

**Some Print Tips to Save You Ink and Paper...** You wish to print some information from an email or a page or part of a page off of the internet, but not the entire document... Highlight the portion you wish to print. Go to the top of your computer and click on **FILE**. From the file menu, click on **PRINT**. From the print window choose **SELECTION...** and click **PRINT**. By leaving your cursor on a particular page you wish to print, follow the above and from the print window choose **CURRENT PAGE**.

**Be Courteous...** Don’t **FORWARD** an email that someone has sent you and include their extensive list of recipients. After you click on **FORWARD**, scroll down and highlight the sender’s list of recipients and **DELETE**. You may not want to include a long list of recipients in your emails. Send them all as **BCC** (blind carbon copy)

## 10 Key Board Gems to Help You Gain Control of Your Computer

1. Find text on any webpage with **Control + F**
2. Undo mistakes with **Control + Z**
3. Re-do your undo with **Control + Y**
4. Print what you’re looking at in Word or your browser with **Control + P**
5. Get home quick (to the beginning of a document) with **Control + Home**
6. Skip to the end of a document with **Control + End**
7. Copy without having to go to Kinkos with **Control + C**
8. Paste without getting sticky with **Control + V**
9. Be bold – highlight letters or words and press **Control + B**
10. Move your cursor one word at a time instead of one character at a time with **Control + Left Arrow**  
**Or Control + Right Arrow**

Extra Tip: Add **SHIFT** to **Control** and an **Arrow** key and you can highlight one word at a time.
