RECONSTRUCTING FAMILY INFORMATION WHEN YOU START WITH ALMOST NOTHING A CASE STUDY – Speaker, Janice Sellers

Janice Sellers is a professional genealogist who specializes in newspapers and Jewish research. She is the editor of two genealogy journals and a member of APG, Genealogical Speakers Guild, and San Francisco Bay Area Jewish Genealogical Society. She has volunteered at the Oakland FHC for eleven years.

With sparse clues and very little solid information, one wonders where to begin researching their family history. In this case study Janice will demonstrate techniques and sources that enabled a researcher, beginning with only the slimmest of remembered information, to reconstruct six generations of a family which emigrated from Eastern Europe to rural western Pennsylvania in the mid-1800s ..

SOME RESEARCH SUGGESTIONS TO MOTIVATE YOU

Have you checked the Social Security Index lately for distant relatives that may have passed away in the last year or so?

Have you found census records for all your ancestors and collateral relations for as many years as possible? You may have overlooked some important clues if not.

Have you Googled ancestors names AND locality/state recently? One never knows where a new lead might be found or where it might take you and information is constantly being updated on the web.

Have you searched the net for archives in localities where your ancestors or collateral relations lived? Check state, county and major library and university catalogs and websites in those areas.

Have you backed up your files? CDs, “thumb” drives and portable hard drives work well for this purpose.

Have you obtained copies of the documents you *promised* yourself you would? Prices keep going up – don’t put it off too long. Same thing goes for those letters you thought you would write to archives, libraries, distant relatives – do it soon.

Have you recently revisited your favorite websites for updated information? Information is added frequently.

Have you searched bookseller websites for books relating to areas where your ancestors lived? Surprising what you might find just browsing these sites.

Have you made copies of your important documents and vital records and stored them in a safe, but convenient, place? The past year was a record for disasters. Be prepared and protect your records.

Have you written those little stories of when “you were young”? Those camping trips, your first bicycle, how you spent your summer vacations, that school teacher that gave you encouragement or the one who gave you a hard time, when you ran away from home, when you broke your leg, the pets you had as a child, were you homesick at summer camp, etc? The grandchildren will love hearing and reading about your childhood experiences.

Do you know how your ancestors earned their livelihood? Where did they get the knowledge to do so, how did they acquire the experience to accept the challenges of their jobs? Wouldn’t you like to know?

Have you visited your local library, Family History Center or genealogical library lately? They may have some new materials you are not aware of.

Have you looked at genealogical podcasts, joined a society in the locality where your ancestors lived, or browsed genealogy related blogs recently? Have you posted some queries on the internet recently?

Now, you cannot say you don’t have anything to do on a cold winter afternoon! Fill a cup with your favorite warm beverage, grab a handful of cookies, and get to it! Hopefully, you will discover something unusual, uncover a vital clue, or solve a “brick wall”. The possibilities and rewards await you. Get to it!

CALAVERAS COUNTY, CALIFORNIA – A Thumbnail Sketch

Calaveras was one of the original counties in the state in 1850. Portions of the county were later reassigned to Amador County (1854) and to Alpine County (1864). Calaveras County is nestled in the “sierra gold country” and was home to the MiWuk Indians in its early days. Calaveras means skulls in Spanish. Many human (assumed to be Indian) skulls have been found along the banks of the Calaveras River, hence its name.

In 2010 the population was 45,578 inhabitants. The first grove of Giant Sequoia Trees was discovered in Calaveras County. The largest gold nugget was found in Carson Hill. Famous for its lode and placer mines, the county at one time was also a principal producer of copper. The county has many caverns, Mercer Caverns being the most popular tourist attraction.

The county seat is located in San Andreas. The only incorporated city in the county is Angeles Camp. This is where Mark Twain heard of the jumping frog tales and consequently based his story, “*The Celebrated Jumping Frog of Calaveras County*”. Each year in May *A Jumping Frog Jubilee* is held at the County Fairgrounds.
